Terreiro do Paço

The "Praça do Comercio", more known as "Terreiro do Paço" is one of the biggest squares in Europe. With more than 36,000m², it's considered as the official Capital and government centre.

Not to mention that the reconstruction of Lisbon, after "the great earthquake that shook Portugal at the time", was possible thanks to this square.

Being the only square that resisted the earthquake, "Terreiro do Paço" was the starting point for the reconstruction. And because of that, the city is practically built around it.

Today, more than 100,000 tourists per year come to visit this square, which makes it one of the biggest and more recommended tourist attraction of Europe.

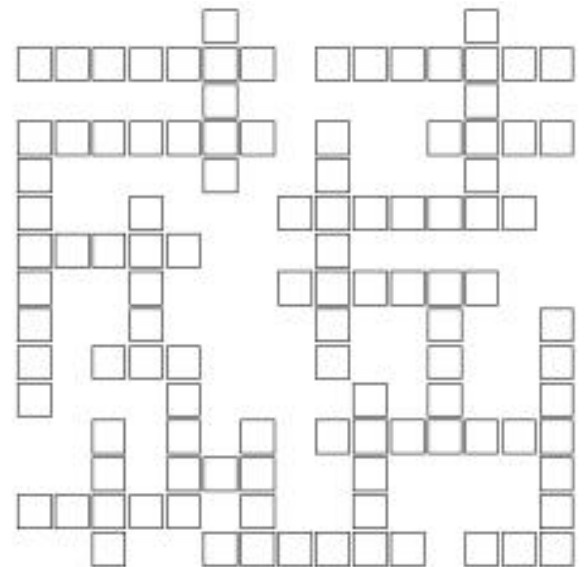
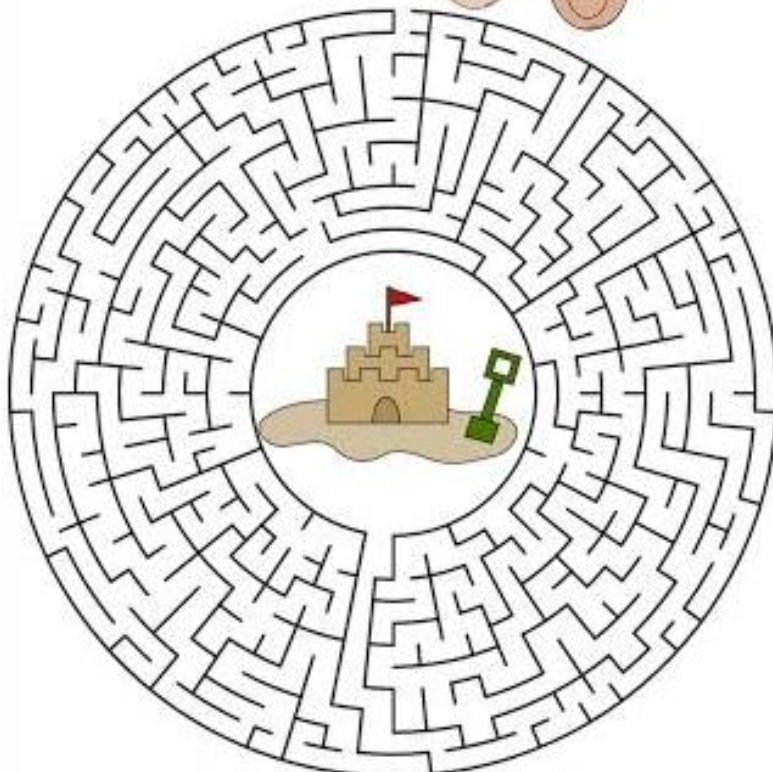
