

My top films

My top films are "Pay it forward", "The impossible", and "The diary of our passion "or "The notebook".

"Pay it forward", is about a teacher Eugene Simonet (Kevin Spacey), that in this class had a student with many problems, Trevor McKinney (Haley Osment). He was a bright kid, 11 years old, trying to help his mother, Arlene McKinney (Helen Hunt), an alcoholic. "The impossible" is about a survivor family in the tsunami in 2004 in Thailand. The family compound Maria (Naomi Watts), Henry (Ewan McGregor) and their children, go to Thailand to stay some days in a tropical paradise. But in the morning of the 26th of December, while the family was around the pool, they heard a noise and a huge water wall coming in the direction of the family.

"The Impossible" is based on real facts and some pictures are from the tsunami that reached Thailand and other areas.

"The diary of our passion" is about two younger people Allie (Rachel McAdams) and Noah (Ryan Gosling) that love deeply during summer holidays. But the couple is quickly separated by Allie's parents because Noah doesn't belong in her world.

Later Allie and Noah meet and their love ignites again, what do with that Allie chooses among the love of her life or her social class.

Ten years later, a man (James Garner) reads an ancient notebook for a woman (Gena Rowlands) that visits regularly an asylum. Although her memory to be a bit weak, bit by bit, she can involve by the presence magic and the miracle happens.


